
## Farm-Fresh Pork

This year we've committed to feeding non-GMO corn. The pigs are given access to fresh pasture and are fed excess garden produce.

Half Hog (~65-90lbs)= \$6.50/lb

Pork is anticipated to be ready in October

Want your hams and bacon fresh (uncured)? We can do that. Just ask!





# **Grassfed Beef**

1/8 cow (~40-50 lbs) = \$7.25/lb

1/4 cow (~80-100 lbs) = \$7.00/lb

1/2 cow (~160-200 lbs) = \$7.00/lb

Hamburger only (sold by the pound, no minimum order size)=\$6.75/lb

Organs and bone marrow: \$3.00/lb

Mixed cut orders available Nov-Jan. Hamburger is available year-round.



Approximately 25% of the beef we sell is produced by Troy Salzer at neighboring Sandy Hills Ranch. Troy has been a long time mentor of our farm. We purchase all of our breeding stock from him, so the beef he provides is consistent with our own grass-fed production. This partnership has helped us maintain supply of hamburger throughout the year.
